Cyprus Attractions

The third largest and most populous island in the Mediterranean, Cyprus is a major tourist destination. Tourism market is one of the largest economic sectors in the island and has experienced substantial growth over the last years, with tourists averaging around 2,3 million per year.

The tourism industry is primarily driven by tourist arrivals during the summer months at the seaside resorts (the key tourist areas are Famagusta, Paphos and Limassol).

However, even if sunlight and sea are the most important tourist incentives, Cyprus aims at expanding its offer to cultural tourism, health and wellbeing and experiential tourism.

Troodos is the largest mountain range in Cyprus, located roughly in the centre of the island. Its highest peak is Mount Olympus, at 1,952 meters it hosts four ski slopes. The mountain range stretches across most of the western side of Cyprus. There are many mountain resorts, Byzantine monasteries, and churches on mountain peaks.

Moreover, flora is the richest in Cyprus and Troodos mountain range is considered one of the most important mountain habitats for plants in the whole of Europe.
